

N-95 MASKS

N-95 masks should be prioritized for high risk patient contact

- WASH HANDS BEFORE AND AFTER REMOVAL OF MASK
- 2 PHYSICALLY INSPECT MASK BEFORE USE
- 3 ENSURE PROPER FIT NEEDS TO COVER NOSE AND MOUTH
- PLACE LOWER STRAP BEHIND NECK
- 5 PLACE TOP STRAP ON BACK OF HEAD
- 6 AVOID TOUCHING INSIDE OF MASK
- 7 IF MASK CONTAINS METAL NOSE BAND, BEND METAL TO SHAPE AROUND NOSE WITHOUT PINCHING AIRWAY
- STORE MASK IN DESIGNATED AREA (BROWN PAPER BAG) OR UNDER CONTROLLED CONDITIONS (UV LIGHT)
- PENCOURAGE PRACTICAL HYGIENE REUSE OF N-95 MASKS SHOULD NOT EXCEED 5 USES
- DISCARD APPROPRIATELY WHEN USE HAS EXPIRED

SURGICAL MASKS

- 1 WASH HANDS BEFORE AND AFTER REMOVAL OF MASK
- PHYSICALLY INSPECT MASK BEFORE USE
- 3 ENSURE PROPER FIT STARTS AT NOSE BRIDGE AND ENDS DOWN PAST THE MOUTH
- 4 AVOID TOUCHING INSIDE OF MASK
- 5 FOLD ENTRANCES SHOULD BE FACING DOWNWARD
- 6 PLACE LEFT ELASTIC BEHIND LEFT
- PLACE RIGHT ELASTIC BEHIND RIGHT EAR
- STORE MASK IN DESIGNATED AREA (BROWN PAPER BAG) OR UNDER CONTROLLED CONDITIONS (UV LIGHT)
- 9 ENCOURAGE PRACTICAL HYGIENE REUSE MASK
- DISCARD APPROPRIATELY WHEN USE HAS EXPIRED (24 HOURS)

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
